



Supplies:

- * Large Paper Plate
- * Red Construction Paper
- * Brown Cardstock
- * Green Paint
- * Paint Brush
- * Black Marker
- * Stapler
- * Scissors
- * Glue

Directions:

- * First trim your paper plate, to look like a triangle/pizza slice. This is the body of the strawberry.
- * Next – using a black marker, have your child make dots all over their red construction paper.
- * Cut your red construction paper into 1×1” squares.
- * Put a good layer of glue on the paper plate.
- * Have your child stick their red squares on the paper plate, until completely covered. Let dry completely.
- * Using the green paint, make handprints on the brown construction paper. Let dry and cut out.
- * Staple the handprints to the top of the “strawberry.”
